MEDIA STATEMENT – LECTURES CONTINUE AT UKZN

Approximately 150 students engaged in protest action at the University of KwaZulu-Natal's Edgewood campus this morning. The South African Police Services (SAPS) and the University's Risk Management Services (RMS) dispersed the students and three students were arrested for contravening the High Court Interdict which protects the University against unlawful, violent and disruptive gatherings and mass action. On the Howard College campus a small group of students have been reported to be engaging in disruptive behaviour. SAPS and Risk Management are managing the situation and a student has been apprehended. Students are assured that lectures are continuing on all five campuses of the University, including the Edgewood campus. The University has beefed up security presence on campus and measures will be taken to ensure that the University's core operations of teaching and learning, remains uninterrupted.
